Government of India Launches Recruitment for National CBDRR Programme under MoPR–NDMA Collaboration New Delhi.

The Ministry of Panchayati Raj (MoPR), in collaboration with the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), has announced the engagement of professionals for the National Programme on Community-Based Disaster Risk Reduction (CBDRR) through Panchayati Raj Institutions.

The programme covers 1,640 Gram Panchayats across 20 States and 81 Districts, aiming to strengthen disaster resilience through integration of Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR), climate change adaptation, ecosystem-based approaches, and AI/ML-enabled decision support systems into Gram Panchayat Development Planning (GPDP).

The initiative seeks to integrate Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR), climate change resilience, ecosystem-based approaches, GIS-based risk mapping, and AI/ML-enabled decision support systems into Gram Panchayat Development Plans (GPDPs).

Objective of the Programme

The initiative aims to strengthen community-led disaster preparedness, climate resilience, and evidence-based planning at the grassroots level by leveraging technology, institutional capacity building, and convergence of government programmes.
